Review of minutes: A motion to approve the minutes was made by Brent Markel, a second by Jenny Foster. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Perina for Sue Smith. Our share (45%) of the outdoor concession profits was \$4372.00, which is low compared to previous years. Band receives 45% and the District receives 10%. The 3 on 3 Suburban Slam made around \$6800.00. Kudos to Kathy Donahue. The Certificate of Deposits we have with People's Bank have made around \$226 in interest. A motion to accept the financial report was made by Celeste Hinnenkamp, a second was made by Marie McInerney. The motion carried.

Assistant Treasurer: Jenny Foster. Jenny recently deposited \$4800 for the Tip-Off Tournament which came from money from ticket sales and concessions.

Athletic Director's Report: Larry Ludwig. Larry mentioned that we have two tournaments coming up. The Wrestling Tournament on December 13th and the Girls' Holiday Basketball Tournament on December 26/27. Julie Winters is chair of the Wrestling Tournament and says she is in good shape with t-shirts, trophies, lunch for coaches, timers and scorekeepers but could use a few more sponsors for individual weight classes. Sponsorship is \$25. Marie McInerney is chairing the Girls' Holiday Tournament and clarifies that the teams working the tickets and door must have adults in those positions.

New Business:

1. Outdoor Concessions: Helen Snyder has resigned and we are in need of a replacement. Bob will send an e-mail to Joan Klinke, head of York Suburban Food Services to find out if anyone in food service would be interested. A food-handling certification is necessary but that can be achieved fairly easily. The job is around 100 hours for the fall season and slightly less for the spring season. An honorarium of around \$2000, averaging out to \$10/hour is given, split up between the two seasons. Please see Bob if you know of anyone who is interested.

Old Business:

1. Concession Stand Pricing: After reviewing other high school concession stand pricing, the committee only ended up changing 3 prices. The Chicken Finger Basket and Walking Taco went up .25 to \$2.25. Tootsie Roll Pops are now .25 each as opposed to 2/.25.
2. Macadam Path: Bob talked to Dr. Orban about the school district helping with funding for this project and was told that there was no long-range plan to put in a macadam path. Dr. Orban said that she would be glad to present the plan to the Planning Committee for approval. Bob asks is this project something we want to do? Marie suggests putting it to a vote. Celeste made a motion for the Booster Club to put in a macadam path. A secret ballot vote was taken and counted by Kim George and Jenny Foster. Bob will send out an e-mail asking for votes from the remainder of the Booster Club position members and have the votes sent to Kim George for counting.
