Tom also was hoping to get into the trophy case to get information on more York Suburban past accomplishments for the website. Larry said not all past trophies would be in showcases, there simply is not enough room so many have been thrown out over the years. He could get a janitor to open the case for him. Tom reiterated to everyone to use the website for team announcements. Tom reported that he has been in touch with YAVarsity for free photos for the website. They will give him free photos if he puts YAVarsity's name on the website; Tom said it has already been done.

1. Outdoor Concessions: Susan will tell Helen Snyder about the concession stand being open more hours this spring. Also, Susan will talk to Darryl Steckler about splitting events between the band boosters and the sport boosters so each group would be responsible for specific events as opposed to every event. Larry noted that Skittles candy should be taken off the indoor concession stand menu as the janitors have complained that they are all over the gym after games. In addition, Tom Sprigle noted that offering fruit and yogurt bars at the Wrestling Tournament would be helpful because the wrestlers have to be careful what they eat before they compete and there wasn't much they could eat at this year's tournament.
