

York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club  
June 1, 2009

The June meeting of the York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club was called to order by President Bob Perina.

Review of Minutes: A motion to approve the May minutes was made by Sue Steckler; a second by Emily Bates. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Sue Smith. The next meeting will start with the final statement for this school year. The Booster Club's portion of spring revenue for the outdoor concession was \$1890 - Sue was very pleased with this. The indoor concession stand had total revenue of \$195. Sue wasn't sure if there were any more outstanding bills for the indoor concessions but the hope is to at least break even - if we make a profit, so much the better. The York Suburban Relays made \$12,776. The total amount of all fundraisers for 2008-09 school year was \$27,328 - the highest amount Sue has seen since she has been part of the Booster Club. Bob adds that lots of costs are associated with teams so you can see why fundraisers are so important. Dan Van Houwe asks if the Booster Club will give a response back when an allocation form has been submitted. Sue says if you don't hear from us, assume there is no problem. A motion was made by Jenny Foster to accept the financial report, with a second from Celeste Hinnenkamp. The motion carried.

Assistant Treasurer: Jenny Foster. No report.

President-Elect: Tom Sprigle. No report.

Athletic Director's Report: Larry Ludwig. Not present. Bob mentions that school sports physicals are this upcoming Wednesday and Monday at OSS. This information is also posted on the website.

New Business:

1. Fall Sports Program - Kim Kerlin, who has been doing the Fall Program for the past 4 years, has put together a checklist for the next chairperson. Kim says this is not a football program but a whole school fall program (as the band and fall sports teams all have their pictures in it). All monies benefit the Booster Club. She said solicitation letters go out at the end of June/early July - ad placement is no problem; many sponsors return year after year. She only solicited potential sponsors through places she did a lot of business with - but this is not necessary. Volunteers are needed for picture day to record the names of athletes in the correct order and spelling, which is towards the end of August. Sarah and Bob Perina will help with this. Meet the Teams Night (August 27) is the last day to acquire ads - Kim sets up a table to sell ads and charms (\$5 good luck messages). September 11th is the first home game so this year there will be a good amount of time to get the program made. Kim says time is involved but it's not overwhelming and when football season is over, you are done! Kim would be glad to go through step by step if anyone needs help.

### 3. Outdoor Concession Stand Update:

Randy says we will run a full menu at the Keystone Games, which is a 4-day event at the end of July that makes \$3,000-\$4,000 for the Booster Club. Randy would like to have an awning above the front of the concession stand windows and he mentions that the District has a contract with Pepsi that has now expired. Randy would like to investigate with the District the possibility of having an awning put up in exchange for their business.

4. Keystone Games - July 23-26. Bob says this is a fun event that needs lots of volunteers. Girls' field hockey will be on both fields bringing in excellent teams and college scouts (we had 16 scouts last year). Please volunteer your time if you can - e-mails will be coming.

Tom mentions that there is a league baseball game on July 11th that perhaps we could open the stand for. He thinks a lot of money could be made.

### 5. Team Allocation Policy

#### a. Coaches Letter (well received by Mr. Greenholt and Larry Ludwig)

Bob encourages all team reps to please read and become familiar with this letter because it will be strongly enforced next year. This year we had some problems with expenses vs. allocation. The whole team must benefit from the money. This does not include travel and/or food expenses for coaches or part of a team. Also, a few allocation requests came in for more money than the team had in their account. Team Reps, please help the coach know the team's allocation amount before placing the request. The treasurer will be able to help you with this; if you aren't sure, call.

#### b. Team Allocation Event Sign-Up - August 24

It is very important to have a representative for your team if you can't attend this meeting. Each event is worth between \$200-250 (we will know the amount by August 24th). Each team can sign up for 4 events (you can sign up for less than 4). If no one shows up to represent the team, events will be randomly assigned to that team.

A motion was made by Kim George to adjourn the meeting. A second was made by Karen Simon. The meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
