

York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club  
June 4, 2007

The June meeting of the York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club was called to order by Club President Susan Smith.

In attendance: Helen Marsteller, Jenny Foster, Marina Roos, Kim and Dan Jones, Marie McInerney, Kathy Donahue, Sarah and Bob Perina, Lois Ann Schroeder

Recording Secretary: The minutes for the previous meeting were not distributed as Lois Ann Schroeder, the recording secretary for the May meeting, could not find them.

Corresponding Secretary: Not present. No report.

Treasurer's Report: Marie McInerney. So far, the total for the York Suburban Relays is \$14,277.35. Larry Ludwig mentioned that \$350 in entry fees is still unpaid and he expects payment over the next several weeks. Marie has put \$7,500 each into 2 CDs at a 5% interest rate at People's Bank.

Allocation: Susan Smith mentioned that most coaches are spending or know about spending their allocations. Most have plans for their money and some will have \$500 carried forward.

Keystone Games: Bob Perina. The Keystone Games is scheduled from Thursday, July 26 through Sunday, July 29 this year. The Booster Club has agreed to do it again this year. York Suburban will host boys and girls basketball, grades 9-12. Bob suggested having one person per day responsible for finding volunteers for that day as a way to help the Keystone Games run smoothly this year. That person would be responsible for getting scorekeepers, timers, ticket takers and concessions workers - around 12 volunteers would be needed per day. Kathy Donahue volunteered to take Thursday, Susan Smith will take Friday, Bob and Sarah Perina will take Saturday and Marie McInerney volunteered to take Sunday. Bob said that the Keystone Games made \$1500 last year. Sarah Perina and Marie McInerney suggested that maps to other venues be available for players and their families as last year most people were not familiar with the area and needed directions. Bob said that a dinner is given by the Keystone Games sometime over the summer to explain things, with a question and answer session following. He will let people know the date of this dinner. Larry Ludwig mentioned that in 2008, the Keystone Games will probably be using the 2 turf fields and so for next year we will also need outdoor concession workers.

President's Report: Susan Smith. With the JV Girl's Volleyball Tournament on September 15, Sue highlighted the need for a Girl's Volleyball team rep. The varsity team usually works the tournament but having a team rep to coordinate would make for a smoothly run tournament.

Kim Wagner has agreed to do the Fall Program again this year. She will need support from us.

Concessions: Helen Marsteller. Outdoor - The Booster Club made \$1307.50 in outdoor concessions this spring. Compared to last year, we made 3/4 more profit this year. Spring \$1100 last year, \$1400 this year. Indoor: Made small amount this year. Need a replacement for Gina Bare.

Membership: Kathy Pike. Not present. Susan Smith said we had one new membership in the month of May. Membership numbers are up by a small amount over last year.

Awards & Flowers: Lois Ann Schroeder. Post-season awards for Boy's Basketball, Girl's Track, and Baseball. These awards are given to teams that win their division or higher. The York Suburban Booster Club pays for this award in which \$25 per athlete is given. Lois Ann stated that \$25 per athlete has been the amount for a long time and suggested that this amount be raised, as a plaque with picture is now around \$27. Lois Ann proposed a motion to increase the amount from \$25 to \$35 per athlete. Jenny Foster seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

School Directory: Mary Lutz will do it again this year and said she will continue until her daughter, Laura, who is going into 11th grade, graduates.

Posters: Julie Little agreed to do Poster Night again this year. The dates are September 5, December 5, and March 18 (All Wednesdays)

Nominating: Positions open

Indoor Concessions: perhaps a committee could do this  
Tip-off and Holiday Tournaments - need someone for soliciting sponsorships (Gina might do it again this year, Marie will ask her); Marie will be in charge of finding volunteers, etc.

Suburban Relays - May 3 (Lynn VanHouwe will continue to help with this event as long as her husband is the track coach)

Spiritwear - possibly a committee

Scholarship Committee - need someone

Marina Roos and Dan Jones will be the Girl's and Boy's Track team reps.

There will be a team rep meeting around the beginning of school to help those new reps understand what it is they will be doing. Bob Perina and Sue Smith will run the meeting.

Scholarship Recipients: Rachel Robertson, Elaine VanHouwe, Kaitlin Eckenrode, Dan Marsteller, Jake Schroeder, and Josh Thompson.

Old Business: In the next 2 weeks, the Booster Club would like to buy 3 pieces of equipment for the weight room: \$2800 Smith machine for squats, \$1700 leg extension machine and a \$1700 curling machine. The leg extension and curling pieces can be used by smaller people (something that is sorely missing in the current weight room). If all 3 pieces are purchased, there is an \$800 discount for a total price of \$6195.01. Susan Smith suggested that the school district pay some of the cost. Larry Ludwig stated he would not know until next week if he had any money left over to spend on the equipment. Bob Perina presented a motion that the Booster Club will fund up to \$4195.01 if the school district will pay \$2000. If the school district does not pay, the York Suburban Booster Club will buy 2 pieces (the Smith machine and the curling machine) and buy the 3rd piece at a later date. Marie McInerney seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Susan Smith wanted everyone to know that we are losing many good people this year because of graduating seniors. Thanks to Becky May, recording secretary, Kathy Monk, corresponding secretary, Lois Ann Shroeder, former president and nominating, Jill Thompson and Deb Lebo, team reps.
