This will be enforced this year. Bob Perina offered a motion to accept the financial report; Tom Sprigle offered a second. The motion carried.

New Business:

1. Team Allocation Plan: Susan Smith and Bob Perina. A draft of the proposed team allocation plan for 2008/2009 was distributed. Susan gave a brief history of the Booster Club allocation. Before 2001/2002, the York Suburban Booster Club had no money. Many teams wanted to have their own booster club but the administration said no. The team allocation started in 2002/2003. At the present time, we have money but many of the coaches are not spending their money and volunteers are becoming increasingly hard to find. It has been decided to put the responsibility of earning allocation money on the coaches/teams instead of the Booster Club. The YS Booster Club's role is one of monitoring and support. The proposed program is a self-directed one. A team would be asked to sign up for 4 events throughout the school year. This is not mandatory and only teams interested in earning money for their team allocation would sign up. Extra events would be available for teams wanting to earn more money. 9<sup>th</sup> grade teams would be invited to take part in signing up for events if there are events left over. Bob Perina made a motion that this proposal will be voted on at the June Booster Club meeting. Dan VanHouwe seconded the motion.

Lynn VanHouwe moved to adjourn the May meeting; Marie McInerney offered a second. The meeting adjourned at 8:30 PM.
