

York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club
May 4, 2009

The May meeting of the York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club was called to order by President Bob Perina.

Review of Minutes: A motion to approve the minutes was made by Kim George; a second by Celeste Hinnenkamp. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Sue Smith. The YS Relays was very profitable again this year, approximately \$10,000 profit so far. The first girls' soccer tournament made a profit of around \$600. There has been much activity this month in team allocation expenditures - cheerleading, boys' and girls' swimming, lacrosse, boys' basketball to name a few. Again, Sue encourages team reps to talk to the coaches about carrying over any leftover monies (\$500 max), must submit by May 15th. A motion to approve the financial report was made by Jenny Foster, with a second made by Bev Schryver. The motion carried.

Assistant Treasurer: Jenny Foster. Jenny has recently deposited money from Volleyball indoor concessions and there should be another deposit this week so that could put our end of the season earnings in the black!

President-Elect: Tom Sprigle. No report.

Athletic Director: Larry Ludwig. Larry reminded Bob to let the district know the Booster Club meeting dates for the school calendar. The fall Meet the Teams Night is scheduled for August 27th but winter and spring dates have not been made. The York Suburban Relays has a new name starting next year - The Herb Schmidt Relays.

Webmaster: Tom Sprigle. No report.

Event Scheduling Manager: Kim George. The first year has run very smoothly. Not one team changed dates, which made it easy.

Tournament Recaps:

1. Girls' Soccer Tournament - went well and York Suburban won their own tournament. Tom Shugars will work with Larry to get a date on the calendar for next year. Bob mentioned that Christina Eckert, Sue and Darrell Steckler did a great job organizing this event!

2. YS Relays - a big thanks to the many volunteers that were needed to make this event so successful. Our single largest fundraiser and this year was no exception!

Membership: Gina Bare. Not present.

Awards/Flowers: Kim Jones. Not present.

School Directory: Mary Lutz. Not present.

Spirit Functions: No report.

Scholarship: Jenny Foster. 30 total applications submitted; 23 students total. This year 3 girls and 3 boys will be awarded scholarships on May 11th at the Awards Ceremony.

New Business:

1. Outdoor Concessions Update - Bob states that we will get a state license for the outdoor concession stand which means we have to get the stand up to code. Bob gives a shout out to Barry Girling, director of facilities, who took money out of his budget to pay for and put in the appropriate sinks. This in turn helped Dr. Orban make the decision to open the stand with a full menu for the York Suburban Relays which sold over \$6000 of food! Over the summer additional work will need to be done by the Booster Club. Incidentally, Bob mentions what a super job Randy Robertson has done keeping the stand running smoothly. We have 3 events left where we will need staff - Special Olympics and the York Cup Soccer Tournament both in May and the Keystone Games in July. Marina Roos asks if these events will have a full menu concession stand. Bob will ask Dr. Orban. Kathy Donahue asks if Helen still is required to do random inspections. Since the stand will be inspected by the state, Helen will not be required to inspect the stand. Bev Schryver questions why these expenses to get the stand up to code are not covered by the district. Bob isn't sure yet what the district will pay. Jenny Foster wonders if the band has to pitch in for improvements made over the summer. Bob answers yes.

2. Positions for 2009/2010 - Some open positions are President-Elect, Membership, Boys' Tip-Off Tournament, Girls' Holiday Tournament and Spirit Posters.

Old Business:

1. Macadam Pathway - The pathway is complete! Check it out.

Marie opens the floor for discussion regarding upgrading the banners in the gym. She thinks the plastic is cheap looking and wonders why we can't have something more like Dallastown's. Larry Ludwig says that the plastic is durable and very easy to clean whereas the fabric banners cost at least \$100 a piece and need to be dry cleaned. He also informs the group that student council actually pays for the banners. Bob suggests that Marie bring it up to student council.

Bob sets the Team Allocation Meeting for Monday, August 24th from 7:00 - 9:00 PM in Room 121 of the high school. Celeste brings up the point that freshman teams need to be able to work dates later in their seasons as the team hasn't been picked yet, which happened this year to the 9th grade boys' basketball team. Bob said we will have to make sure that the freshman teams will be able to pick earlier in the process to ensure they get some choice with dates.

Marina Roos made a motion to adjourn the May meeting. Marie McInerney offered a second. The meeting adjourned at 8:08 PM.
