

York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club
November 12, 2007

The November meeting of the York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club was called to order by Club President Susan Smith at 7:20 PM at the York Suburban High School.

Review of Minutes: Corrections to the October minutes include: Eric Grove is the name of the website creator (not Mark); for the outdoor concession stand, we took in \$3,000 at one football game (not \$3,000 profit for the season). A motion to approve the corrected minutes was made by Bob Perina, a second by Marie McInerney.

Treasurer's Report: Marie McInerney. Marie mentioned that all bills were paid for the 3 on 3 basketball tournament (which made around \$5800), with the exception of a janitor bill which is in dispute. With the hours of the tournament the same as last year, the hours billed for janitorial services this year were for 5 hours more than last year's event. Larry said he would talk to the appropriate people regarding the bill. Also, Marie has received 2 more team fees for the girls' volleyball tournament. There are still quite a few teams that have not paid yet; Marie will get a list of teams that still owe money and give to Larry so he can contact the appropriate people. The fall program money has been deposited and the total is \$4990 with Print-O-Stat the only outstanding bill yet to be paid. Marie noted that there are still some fall sports teams that have not spent their allocations.

Assistant Treasurer's Report: Jenny Foster. No report.

Athletic Director's Report: Larry Ludwig. Larry said that at least 4 teams are needed for the Girls' soccer tournament scheduled at York Suburban for this spring. He will put a request for teams on the district website.

Webmaster: Tom Sprigle. Tom will be adding more information to the website next week. He has an e-mail in to YAVarsity to set up an account. YAVarsity has agreed to supply pictures for the website at a reduced cost. Also, Tom thought having a section on the website for the Athletic Director to post information would be a great idea. Larry said he could do that. Lisa Schmittle asked Tom if there was any way to have the website address displayed prominently so students and parents would have easy access to it? Lisa also suggested an article about the website in the school newspaper to get the word out. Sue will talk to someone about that. Since York Suburban swimming has its own website (YSSwimming.org), Tom suggested linking it to the Booster Club

website. Also, having an athlete of the week or month was suggested as an idea. Larry wondered who would have the job of choosing the athletes.

Fundraising

2. We have 3 tournaments coming up soon:

3. Outdoor Concessions: Sue said that Helen Marsteller updated her with the final profit for the fall: Before Helen Snyder's honorarium, the outdoor concession stand realized a \$19,000 profit. The Booster Club gets 45%, around \$8,000, which is \$3,000 more than last year.

Awards/Flowers: Kim Jones. Not present. Winding down, all went well; Kim did a great job.
