Athletic Department Report -- Chris Adams

- Fall started off well.
- *Spring Conflict: The Herb Smith Relays* fall on Easter and will present a conflict in future years. We are in the process of moving the event to the first weekend in April. With this new date, there is only one year within the next 5-8 years when the event would fall on Easter (next year). We have support from all the other schools.
- *Fall Program:* The Design Studio class will do a program for us this fall and winter. Send advertisers to Chris.
- *Concession Stand- Wrestling Tournament:* There are 8 teams participating. We have built in breaks so people can visit the concession stands.

Update on Boys Tournament

- Kiersten did a great job getting of getting sponsors.
- Sold a lot of Gatorade. Sold \$120 in t-shirts and \$921 in food.
- Tournament Tents: Down to 2 tournament tents. They are expensive to replace and will be needed for the Herb Schmidt relays.
 - We lose them because people borrow them and they do not return them.
 - We could rent them, instead of purchasing them, or we could get a rental company to sponsor a tent.

JV Volleyball-- Carol

- Disappointed that only 5 families donated food.
- Basketball people will be staffing the concession stands for the tournament. There will be three 15 minute games-- ending between 4-6.
- Boosters will stock the food.
 - BJ's will put you on a donation list. See the manager 6 weeks before you need the items. Right now they are taking names for October.
 - Big Apple Bagels: Write a letter on Booster Club letterhead to get your name on a list. You will get big garbage bags full of bagels.
- Sponsor letters went out and registration letters for the Booster Club went out.

(Hot dog roller was used by TAC all summer so we will try to track it down.)
 - Carol and Leslie cleaned out the storage cabinet and threw out old food. \$300 has been spent by Carol, so it is restocked.
 - Try to streamline concession items, so we do not end up with such a diverse quantity of leftovers.
 - When you are manning concessions, ask parents who will bake because that is pure profit.
 - Basketball generates a lot of revenue. Other teams do not make very much money. We do this at all games as a courtesy.
