Banquets:

1. Booster Club will provide up to \$125 to the following teams:
Golf, Girls Tennis, Boys Tennis, Girls Volleyball, Boys Volleyball, 9th grade and HS Boys Basketball, 9th grade and HS Girls Basketball, Wrestling, Field Hockey, Boys Cross Country, Girls Cross Country, 9th grade Football, HS Football, Girls Soccer, Boys Soccer, Baseball, Softball, Girls Lacrosse, Boys Lacrosse, Girls Swimming, boys Swimming, Girls and Boys Track and Field and Cheerleading
2. Booster club money can be used on food or paper goods for a Banquet "Pot Luck" and/ or Awards Ceremony refreshments. Please submit this form with receipts to Missy for reimbursement. The Coach or "Team Parent" may purchase the item(s) if he/she chooses. Receipts (original) are required for reimbursement. All other purchase (over \$125) will be the responsibility of the person(s) making the purchase for your team.
3. The Booster Club does not provide drinks, paper goods, cake/cookies, **balloons or decorations**. Please keep that in mind when planning your event (and how you will spend your \$\$)

Awards and Flowers:

- The awards are \$9 a piece. Please try to generate some different ideas to replace this expense.

Membership

Each year, the booster club provides:

- Eight \$500.00 scholarships to senior athletes
- Monies to subsidize season-end celebration and awards ceremonies
- Monies for team equipment and uniform purchases
- Corsages for parents of senior athletes on senior recognition night
- School directory for high school students
- Outdoor and indoor concessions for sports
- Sponsorship of the Boys' Soccer Tournament, Boys' Basketball 3v3, Boys' Basketball Tip-off Tournament, Holiday Girls' Basketball Tournament, JV Girls' Volleyball, Boys Wrestling Tournament and Herb Schmidt Relays

Membership doing better than last year.

- This Year: \$3,150 so far-- but we have a goal of reaching \$4000 to cover 8 scholarships. Last Year \$3,020

Membership Levels:

- *Basic Membership:* \$15 per family
- *Orange and Black Membership:* \$30 per family
 - Includes 2 one-time passes to any home regular season game
- *Trojan Membership:* \$50 per family
 - Includes 6 one-time passes to any home regular season game
- *Trojan Legacy Membership:* \$100 per family
 - Includes 10 one-time passes to any home regular season game

The highest membership is within the track team.

Scholarships:

- As of November 4, 2013, total membership dollars is \$3150 -- but we have a goal of reaching \$4000 to cover 8 scholarships.
- We should make more money if we want to give more scholarships
- Try to get scholarship applications into the hands of parents. So far we have 7 applications and we want to give more scholarships.
- Due dates for applications are: November 17, January 10th, and April 7th.
- Application for senior and coach
 - 150 word essay question
 - Applicants use student number instead of name on application
 - Judges are 2 student alumni and a former teacher
 - Can submit an application for each sport played.
