### ***Update on Tournaments***

- Wrestling Tournament: Boys' Tipoff
  - Rescheduled for February 8, 2014
  - Next year picked up two more teams.
  - Dallastown, West York, and Suburban make it a good draw.
  - Make it a local tournament to draw more people.
- Basketball Tournament
  - Approximately \$2,400 net profit
  - Final Totals will be in next month
- Tournament Concession Stands
  - Need more food for concession stands during tournaments
  - Start process early and get all booster reps involved

### ***Membership***

- Total \$3,690 in membership dollars
- Look at how many kids are on your roster and encourage them to join.
- It is optional but we need people to become members. It is hard to ask for money, but it is important.

## ***Outdoor/Indoor Stand: Leslie Platts***

- ***Indoor Stand:***
  - Swim Meet: One whole team did not show up, so concession stand selling time was shortened and less profit.
  - Wrestling Tournament: Controversy over a separate concession stand that was set up in Booster Clubs' usual spot. Booster Club concession stand was set up in the opposite end. Both concession stand sold the same items. Leslie had purchased a large quantity of food to prepare for the event and parents had baked food to sell. The Booster Club lost money and food had to be given away at the end of the night. Wrestling concession stand made enough money to cover the cost of the tournament.
    - Conclusion: This was an unusual situation and will not happen again for several years because the Tri-Meet rotates to other schools. In the future, Booster Club President will be notified of concession stands so that food planning can be modified.
  - Postponed wrestling tournament: February 8. There will be 8 teams. They are set up so that 2 teams are always off to buy concessions.
  - NOTE: ***Important!***
    - Concession stands must have an adult that is on the Booster Club present at all times.
    - Sports teams will lose allocation when people do not fulfill concession obligation.
    - Call Missy if you are not sure whether a concession stand is needed.
  - On snow days, the administration decides whether or not to hold a sports event.

- ***Outdoor Stand:***
  - Please read the manual.
  - Make sure to turn off appliances when you leave.
  - Every dollar we make is shared with the band boosters.
  - Make executive decisions. If you run out of hot dogs, take money and buy some pizzas. Remember that we are volunteers and just work with what you have.

## ***Fundraising:***

- Have to think of new ways to make money.
  - Concession Stands do not make as much money as they used to make.
  - Leslie Platts has had success in getting parents to bring food in for concession stand.

- Fundraising should be done under Booster Club umbrella.
  - Companies can donate to the Booster Club and earmark it for a specific team.
- Uniforms are the biggest expense and biggest need right now.
- March Meeting.
  - We will be scheduling relays at the March meeting, so teams that need extra funds will have an opportunity to make some additional money.
- T-shirts need to be sold. There are 170 Army green and grey t-shirts that say “Wag Your Tail”.
  - Jordan Shoff will get people to sell t-shirts for \$12/ shirt at her lunch period.
