Treasurer's Report: Jane

- Made \$9500 at Herb Schmidt Relays
 - This number is better than the profits in the last few years.
- If you have any issue regarding funding or expenses, please see Jane or Missy.
- All requests need to go through A.D., then Mr. Ellis, and then Missy.
- Total available Booster Club Funds \$20,934.47 (See Balance Sheet April 7, 2014)

Scholarship -- Jerry

- 53 total essays have been submitted through scholarship applications.
- Total of 38 respondents
 - 3 triple season athletes.
 - 9 double season athletes.
 - 26 single season athletes.
- We have funding for 10 scholarships.
- Carol will draft a formal policy, so that scholarships can become part of Missy's legacy during her presidency.
- The scholarships will be presented at the awards ceremony.

Membership

- Made membership quota.
- Total \$3,700 in membership dollars
- Look at how many kids are on your roster and encourage them to join.
- It is optional but we need people to become members. It is hard to ask for money, but it is important.
- Passes can be used next year also.

Tournament

- Thank you to everyone who volunteered for the Herb Schmidt Relays and especially to Carol, Kathy and Josh who ran the event.
- Carol, Kathy and Josh did an excellent job! The tournament was very successful.
- It made a huge profit: \$9,500.
- Carol Kauffman sent out an email asking for donations. She listed specific items and quantities. All of the items were signed up for. This resulted in 98% profit for the event. Carol only spent \$50 for pretzels.
- We now have \$22,000 in reserves.
- Next year it is very important to think about sponsors for the program. This is a great source of funding. This year we were up \$1400. The closest we have come to that much in sponsorship dollars was 2008 when we made \$1300.
- Next year, could publicize Herb Schmidt Relays on Twitter, Facebook, and the school newsletter.
- Meet the Teams Night-- Could ask for donations for concession stands.

Banquet

- Don't forget to turn in receipts.
- Only for paper goods and some food items.

Concession Stands

- Need baked goods donations by 5:30 on White Out Thursday, April 9th.
- Remember to individually wrap items.
- Display food attractively in the front of the stand on the table and it will sell better.
- Lacrosse kids sold the rest of the candy and made \$167.

Outdoor Concession Stands

- Need outdoor treasurer.
- We are looking for someone to run the outdoor stand. It could be one person or a committee.
