New Business:

Election of President-Elect:

Requested Amendment of By-Laws:

Chris Adams (outgoing Athletic Director) requested that all invoices be submitted for approval/reimbursement by May 31 of each school year. The change was moved and seconded. A revised policy will be circulated for the Club's review. ***Please make your coaches aware of this policy change (especially Spring Sports).***

Small Games of Chance - The Booster Club has the opportunity to secure a small games of chance license. The District will support this initiative. A general consensus was obtained from the representatives in attendance to move forward with obtaining the license. It is anticipated that the licensing process will be completed for implantation during the 2017-2018 school year. An update will be provided at the next meeting.

Athletic Director Report:

Matt Marshall introduced himself as the new Athletic Director for the High School.

Treasurer's Report:

Michelle distributed the Financial Report for the 2015-2016 School Year.

Allocations will be emailed once finalized. There were some outstanding invoicing issues from last school year that need to be resolved.

Boys' JV Volleyball Futures Tournament made a profit last year of \$3,445.78, which is a substantial improvement from the prior year.

Please communicate with your coaches and update them frequently concerning allocation balances. There is approximately a two week turnaround to get invoices paid so timely submission is important.
