Treasurer's Report:

Boys'/Girls' Soccer Tournament made over \$4,300. Girls' Volleyball Tournament totals have not been finalized just yet, but will likely end up over \$4,000.

There was a cancelled Soccer Game that Track was assigned to cover. Track will be given an extra pick during the Winter work assignment selection.

Please try to make all scheduled work assignments. Please double-check with your parents to make sure they cover assignments they have volunteered for.

Reminder: It is very important that you check with Michelle to see what your team balance is before your coaches make any purchases. Please communicate with your coaches and update them frequently concerning allocation balances. There is approximately a two week turnaround to get invoices paid so timely submission is important. The allocation reimbursement form can be found on the Booster Club page on the District website.

Indoor Concessions:

Donations are always encouraged and accepted. The more donated items, the bigger the profit for the Boosters.

Money Process: Please tell your parents (or whoever is manning the indoor stand at an event) that at the end of the event it is **imperative** that they get money into the hands of the school representative at the event (typically, Mr. Marshall). Please have them complete the cash form in *duplicate*, keeping one copy with the money, and putting one in the binder. There is no need to count the change in the drawer.

Tournaments:

Jess Barley reported on the upcoming Girls' Basketball Tournament. Sponsorships will be \$150. The plan is to promote the Tournament as a YSASBC event with support sought from all team representatives. This is the only Winter YSASBC tournament. Boys' Tip Off Tournament will be back but likely not until the 2018-2019 school year. Trojan Wrestling Club

will be hosting a tournament this winter, with a new format. Denny Heffern will provide the Club with a report on this tournament after it takes place.

Scholarships:

As of tonight, there were no applications from the Fall seniors. Matt Marshall will talk with the players/coaches about applying. It was noted that the website needs to be updated with the current seasonal deadlines. One week after the deadline has passed, Matt Marshall will follow up with coaches to make sure they have done their part by way of recommendations.

Fundraising:

- Kris Marino has volunteered to take over the organization of the yard sign fundraiser. It is the plan to get a better system in place so that parents have their signs earlier in the sports seasons.

Spirit Wear:
