**Meeting policy** – Given that most of our communication is done via email, we will continue with the bi-monthly meeting schedule. All meetings will be at 7 p.m. in the Large Guidance Conference Room unless notified otherwise. Refer to the District Calendar for all meeting dates.

**Board Meeting with Administration** – Kristin and Josh met with Dr. Merkle and the other parent run organizations in the District. We were strongly encouraged to finalize and obtain our 501(c)(3) designation. Representatives were asked to seek out any attorneys/accountants who could donate their services to us.

**Fall Parent Meetings** – Kristin has been trying to attend all parent meetings. The upcoming meetings will be attended by at least one Board Member to advertise and educate people on the Booster Club and how they can help.

### **Concession Stand Issues:**

a. SYSCO – a new food supplier contract is being utilized for this year. SYSCO will provide food for the concession stands. They are the current food supplier for Whitsons, our District wide cafeteria management team. The benefits include online ordering, as well as delivery and stocking of the items in the Big Orange Café. Hopefully, this streamlines and makes managing the outdoor concession stand much easier.

b. Refrigerator/Ice Machine/Freezer – All have needed extensive repairs in the past few years. Bids are being sought to replace that equipment. Ron Simmer will provide Josh Leik with information for a surplus/liquidation restaurant equipment supplier in Harrisburg.

c. Price increases were also discussed. Comments were voiced that our concessions are priced significantly lower than other schools. The concern is over-pricing our items and making it difficult for students to purchase food at events. The menus will be reviewed and suggestions for pricing will be discussed at future meetings.

d. At the conclusion of the meeting, Jen Culbertson agreed to take on the Concession Stand Committee position. Thank you, Jen!!

### **Athletic Director Report (Matt Marshall)**

1. Matt Marshall began by thanking representatives for all the hard work throughout the school year, not just your sports season.

2. We have 281 High School students participating in fall sports (30% of the student population).

3. The Soccer Tournament will feature 8 teams (4 boys, 4 girls) and the Girls' Volleyball tournament will feature 15 teams.
