ATHLETIC DIRECTOR REPORT – RON COURSEY

- Ron clarified the boys and girls charter bus for basketball the overage from the normal school bus charge is paid from their respective booster club accounts.
- Ron discussed opportunity for us to work with S3 Performance Training. Ron has been in discussions with the owner, John Terpak.
- The time slots would be based on Teams.
- This would be a 12 week program, run after school 3 – 5. The days would be Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
- Ron's indicated feedback from the coaches 1/3rd not interested 2/3rds interested.
- A coach will need to be in the room with the students.
- There will be an app to track their progress.
- S3 will bring any additional equipment needed.
- The cost will be \$3,600 for 12 weeks, no limit on number of students.
- Asking booster club teams to each contribute \$100 toward the \$3,600.
- All Sports General fund will pay the balance.
- The initial cost is a discounted \$3,600, full price is \$4,500 to \$5,000.
- How do we know which coaches opted out? Discussed Ron needed to have honest respectful conversations with coaches.
- Jess Carter made a motion to vote to approve the funds out of the general fund. Sara Kline seconded the motion. Swim is opposed, all other teams vote yes.

- Jess Carter made a motion to vote to approve \$100 team allocation to S3 fees, Sheila Powers seconds the motion. Swim is opposed. All other teams vote yes.
